Dear WESD Families and Staff,

Our schools and our staff are ready for those of you returning and those of you remaining on line. They have practiced mitigation strategies and will be going over them with your returning child.

During Spring Break, we ask that our families follow the mitigation strategies too, which will limit the community transmission. Please wear a well-fitted mask, please wash your hands frequently, please social distance to the best of your ability and please stay home if you are sick. ### **Maricopa County Department of Public Health and Arizona Department of Health Services Dashboards**

This week, Maricopa County Department of Public Health (MCDPH) updated its school data dashboard to reflect the two metrics the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) uses to determine community transmission levels of COVID-19: cases per 100k people and percent positivity.

While the overall transmission level in Maricopa County is still substantial, both metrics continue to decline in WESD. The dashboard data from MCDPH and the Arizona Department of Health Services are shown at the end of this communication.

It's important to emphasize that while schools are in-person, they must ensure universal and correct use of masks, physical distancing, handwashing and respiratory etiquette, cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities and contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantining.

### **Chromebook and Hotspot Return**

In order to ensure that classrooms will have technology to use in the classroom, students who checked out a Chromebook and hotspot and are returning for in-person learning, **must bring their Chromebook, hotspot**


