Thank you for your patience as we work to communicate as we rethe many questions related to COVID-19. We want you to know that we care about, your child and your family. This is a fluid situation so thank you for your understanding

As we shared SundaGovernor Doug Docey and Superintendent Kathy Hoffman directed a statewide closure of all schools in Arizona through Friday, March 27. The WESD leadership team has been meeting plan for next week's closure, as well the possibility of an extended closure. Below are a few updates:

x <u>Food and Nutrition</u>: The WESD will provide free breakfast and lunch from 10:30 a.m. to noon March 23 – 27 at 13 sites. Meals will be available rive though or pick up. Children can pick up one sack lunch for that afternoon and one sack breakfast for the following day. All children 18 and under qualify and they do not have to be students in

- the front officeof their child(ren)'s schooletween 10:30 a.m. and 2 p.m. Medications may only be picked up bythe child's parent. For safety purposes will be practicing social distancing and limiting the number of people in the Health Office at one time.

- x <u>Deep Cleaning</u> Our facilities managers conducted a deep clean of schools during the break, disinfecting high touch areas. Additionally, Nutrition Services and Facilities staff will continue increased precautions ensure the health and safety of students and staff during the preparation and meal delivery program.
- x <u>Large Events</u>: The WESD Art Show at ASU West scheduled for Tuesday, March 24 has been canceled and the two community meetings regarding boundary/grade configuration changes at Desert View, Royal Palm, Maryland and Ocotillo have been postponed.

- x <u>Facility Usage</u> WESD has suspended all facility use rentals of buildings and fields through June 1.
