To maintain a positive, productive learning environment and assure confidentiality for students and teachers during online learning, all families are asked to follow the following privacy guidelines.

Any confidential or personally identifiable information related to students participating during Google Meet should not be collected, discussed or shared.

Family members should not engage with students during Google Meet classes. If you need to speak with your child during a check-in session, first mute your child's microphone.

If a family member has a question, please email your child's teacher. It is not permitted to speak to your child's teacher through the Google Meet during class in order to protect the learning environment and your privacy/confidentiality.
