MANDATORY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

The purpose of the policy is to enhance a positive, productive and safe school environment that contributes to increased student achievement. Description of Uniform Requirements The uniform, for all Palo Verde students, shall consist of the following:

- 3rd Out-of-class Isolation: Parent/Teacher Conference scheduled. Student put on a behavior contract.
